Submission Requirements

>> Language

English is the official language of the conference; the paper should be written and presented only in English.

- >> Submission Type
- \* Abstract submission for presentation only without publication.
- \* Full paper submission for both presentation and publication.

#### >> Paper Length

Each full paper should be no less than 8 pages, including all figures, tables, and references. When it exceeds 10 pages, extra page will be charged at 60 USD / 400 RMB per page.

>>Papers submitted to the conference should report original, previously unpublished research results, experiments or theories and must not be under consideration for publication elsewhere.

## **Visa Application**

Foreign participants usually need a visa to enter China. You are advised to submit your visa application to the appropriate authorities as early as possible, in order not to delay your travel plan.

We recommend that you apply for a tourist visa (category L), which is the simplest and fastest one. Before submitting your application, please always check with the Chinese Embassies or Consulates General in your local region for the latest information. You may find a complete list of Chinese Embassies and Consulates General here. In many countries (except the US), the tourist visa may be applied through the Chinese Visa Application Service Center. Note that applications sent by postal mails are usually not accepted.

#### L Visa

For your reference, we list here the necessary items you will need for the <u>L visa according to here</u>. Please remember to check with the Chinese Embassies or Consulates General in your local region for the complete requirements.

1. Passport: Original signed passport with at least six months of remaining validity and blank visa pages, and a copy of the passport's data page and the photo page if it is separate.

2. Visa Application Form and Photo: One completed Visa Application Form with a photo on glossy photo paper glued onto the form (your photo must meet the requirements).

3. Documents showing the itinerary including air ticket booking record (round trip) and proof of a hotel reservation. Note that you usually don't need an invitation letter for the L visa.

## About Xi'an

Xi'an, capital city of Northwest China's Shaanxi province, served as the capital of 13 dynasties in Chinese history, including the Western Zhou (c.11th century-771 BC) and Tang (618 – 907) dynasties.

Known as Chang'an in ancient times, Xi'an was the starting point of the ancient Silk Road. As such, it boasts many famous scenic spots and possesses six world cultural heritage sites, such as the Mausoleum of Emperor Qinshihuang, Site of Weiyang Palace and Giant Wild Goose Pagoda.

In recent years, Datang Everbright City has also become a must-visit place in Xi'an.

Also, as a food city, Xi'an's snacks are favored by tourists at home and abroad. The famous "Chinese hamburger," steamed cold noodle and Paomo (shredded bread soaked in mutton or beef soup) are all top choices for foodies.
